O P I N I O N

Mueller Truck Co., presently operating as a highway common carrier, requests that an existing restriction set forth in its certificated authority be amended to read as follows:

"Sodium (Soda) hypochlorite solution; cleaning compounds; laundry bleach, dry; and animal litter, viz., chopped alfalfa pellets, originating at Vernon, California, and pallets used in such transportation destined to Vernon."

The proposed amendment adds the commodities of "cleaning compounds; laundry bleach, dry; and animal litter, viz., chopped alfalfa pellets." It also deletes the present commodity exclusion of "liquid sodium hydroxide."

It is alleged that applicant presently serves a shipper of commodities at Vernon, as a permitted carrier, pursuant to the present exclusionary provision; that said shipper has requested applicant to also provide service for the additional commodities set forth in the restriction; and that "liquid sodium hydroxide" is to be deleted from the restriction because it is a commodity which is no longer being produced by the shipper.

After consideration, the Commission finds that the proposed restriction would not be adverse to the public interest.

O R D E R


IT IS ORDERED that:


1. Appendix A of Decision No. 53261 is hereby amended by incorporating Fourth Revised Page 3, attached hereto and by reference made a part hereof, in place of Third Revised Page 3.


2. Within sixty days after the effective date hereof applicant shall amend its tariffs presently on file with this Commission to reflect the authority herein granted.


The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.

Applicant shall not transport any shipments of:

1. Used household goods and personal effects not packed in accordance with the crated property requirements set forth in Item No. 5 of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 4-B.
2. Automobiles, trucks and buses, viz.: new and used, finished or unfinished passenger automobiles, (including jeeps), ambulances, hearses and taxis; freight automobiles, automobile chassis, trucks, truck chassis, truck trailers, trucks and trailers combined, buses and bus chassis.
3. Livestock, viz.: bucks, bulls, calves, cattle, cows, dairy cattle, ewes, goats, hogs, horses, kids, lambs, oxen, pigs, sheep, sheep camp outfits, sows, steers, stags or swine.
- * 4. Commodities requiring the use of special refrigeration or temperature control in specially designed and constructed refrigerator equipment.
5. Liquids, compressed gases, commodities in semi-plastic form and commodities in suspension in liquids in bulk, in tank trucks, tank trailers, tank semitrailers or a combination of such highway vehicles.
6. Commodities when transported in bulk in dump trucks or in hopper-type trucks.
7. Commodities when transported in motor vehicles equipped for mechanical mixing in transit.
8. Logs.
9. Sodium (Soda) hypochlorite solution; cleaning compounds; laundry bleach, dry; and animal litter, viz., chopped alfalfa pellets, originating at Vernon, California, and pallets used in such transportation destined to Vernon.

* Does not apply for shipments between the San Diego Territory, on the one hand, and the City of Los Angeles, on the other hand, serving no intermediate points.
