ORDER GRANTING LEAVE TO INTERVENE

On June 2, 1971, Swift Aire Lines, Inc. (Swift) filed a protest and petition to intervene in the captioned proceeding.

Swift asserts that it presently serves two of the routes proposed in the instant application (between Los Angeles and San Luis Obispo, and between San Luis Obispo and San Francisco); that Swift has pioneered said routes; and that introduction of competing service over said routes would result in financial loss to both carriers involved.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that petitioner Swift Aire Lines, Inc. is granted leave to intervene in Application No. 52646.
