## FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

is a highway common carrier operating under a certificate of public convenience and necessity issued by this Commission. By Certificate of Amendment of Articles of Incorporation, duly filed with the Secretary of State of the State of California on May 20, 1971, Griley changed its corporate name to Griley Freightlines, a corporation. A Petition for Change of Corporate Name having been filed by Griley, its certificate will be amended to show the new corporate name and it will be ordered to amend its tariffs pursuant to General Order No. 80-A. A public hearing is not necessary.

## IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Decision No. 62796 dated November 14, 1961, in Application No. 43248 is amended by substituting "Griley Freight-lines, a corporation" in place and stead of "Griley Security Freight Lines, a corporation."

2. Within one hundred and twenty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than 10 days' notice to the Commission and to the public, Griley Freightlines, a corporation, shall amend its tariffs on file with this Commission as required by Rule No. 6.4 of General Order No. 80-A.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
