OPINION AND ORDER
CANCELLING CERTIFICATE

On April 28, 1970, applicant filed a request for a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing it to operate as an express corporation as defined in Section 219 of the Public Utilities Code. Decision No. 77646, dated August 25, 1970, granted the certificate ex parte on condition that applicant file a written acceptance of the certificate within thirty days. On May 4, 1971, applicant rejected the certificate.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore authorized by Decision No. 77646 is canceled.
