ORDER EXTENDING PERIOD OF SUSPENSION

On January 26, 1971, the Commission issued an Order of Suspension and Investigation in Case No. 9184, suspending to and including July 4, 1971, the effective date of certain tariff sheets filed under Advice Letter No. 4 by Kern Radio Dispatch.

The Commission finds that a decision in the matters cannot be rendered by said date of July 4, 1971, and further that the period of suspension of said tariff sheets should be extended; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the operation and effectiveness of the tariff sheets filed by Advice Letter No. 4 are hereby suspended to and including November 1, 1971, unless otherwise hereafter ordered.
