<u>O P I N I O N</u>

San Jose Water Works requests authority to increase its rates for water service.

Applicant is presently engaged as a public utility in the business of supplying water to domestic, commercial and industrial customers in San Jose, Los Gatos, Saratoga and Monte Sereno and in portions of Campbell, Cupertino and Santa Clara and in territory in the County of Santa Clara surrounding and adjacent to these municipalities. It requests an 0.91 percent increase in rates for metered service to offset the effects of increases in pump tax, purchased power and postage. The requested increase would add approximately 8 cents to the monthly bill of a typical commercial customer with a consumption of 2,175 cubic feet per month.

The present rate schedules now in effect are those authorized by Decision No. 77766, which became effective October 12, 1970. The Commission therein found that said rates should produce a rate of return of 7.4 percent over a period of 36 months based upon the estimated results of operations for the test year 1970. Said estimate was predicated upon the pump tax rates, the postal rates and the

purchased power rates which were in effect as of September 1970. Since that time the pump tax imposed upon ground water extracted by the Santa Clara Valley Water Conservation District has been increased from \$29 per acre-foot to \$30 per acre-foot effective July 1, 1971. The rate for first class postage was increased from 6 cents per ounce to 8 cents per ounce as of May 17, 1971. The cost of electric power purchased by applicant from Pacific Gas and Electric Company was increased 7 percent pursuant to an authorized increase in electrical rates effective February 13, 1971.

The annual total of these three increases in expenses is \$167,000. To offset these increases applicant proposes to revise its quantity rates for general metered service as set forth in Exhibit G attached to the application.

After consideration the Commission finds that:

1. Applicant has experienced increases in pump tex, postage cost and power cost.

2. The increase in postage is not an appropriate expense item to be considered for an offset rate increase.

3. The increases authorized herein will offset the increased expenses resulting from the increases in pump tax and power cost.

4. The earnings which would be produced under the rates authorized herein do not exceed the previously authorized rate of return.

5. The increases authorized herein are just and reasonable.

The Commission therefore concludes that the application should be granted to the extent set forth in the order which follows.
