SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Applicant has advised the Commission that recent damage to the propulsion system of the vessel G. T. Avalon cannot be repaired in time to commence service within the limits of the time established by Decision No. 78328, dated February 17, 1971 in this proceeding and requests an extension of 60 days within which to commence service. The extension will be granted.

IT IS ORDERED that the phrase "one hundred eighty days" is substituted for the phrase "one hundred twenty days" appearing in subparagraph (b) on page 27 of Decision No. 78328, dated February 17, 1971 in this proceeding. In all other respects Decision No. 78328 shall remain in full force and effect.
