ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision No. 76377 dated November 4, 1969, in Application No. 51373, Roy Stanton aba Chico Transit Lines was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation between the City of Chico and the Cities of Paradise and Oroville.

Roy Stanton dos Chico Transit Lines has stated in writing that he discontinued service due to unprofitable operating experience. The carrier discontinued service on or about March 3, 1970.

It appears and the Commission finds that these matters constitute good cause for the revocation of the aforenamed certificate. The Commission, therefore, concludes that the certificate should be revoked and that tariffs and timetables applicable to the service thereunder should be canceled.

and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation between the City of Chico and the Cities of Paradise and Oroville and intermediate points authorized by Decision No. 76377 in Application No. 51373 is hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of Roy Stanton dba Chico Transit Lines are canceled upon the effective date of this order.
