ORDER OF DISCONTINUANCE

On September 22, 1970, the Commission issued an order of suspension and investigation which suspended the effective date of "One-Way Radio Paging Communications", Schedule L-2, which provides a new offering of one-way paging service, filed by Hanford Mobile Radio, Inc., (Hanford) under Advice Letter No. 5 until January 24, 1971.

By Decision No. 78189, dated January 19, 1971, the suspension of the effective date of "One-Way Radio Paging Communications", Schedule L-2, filed by Hanford Mobile Radio, Inc., under Advice Letter No. 5 was extended to, and including, July 24, 1971.

On July 12, 1971, Hanford's president telephoned the Commission staff and requested that Advice Letter No. 5 be permanently suspended.

Good cause appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. Advice Letter No. 5, filed by Hanford Mobile Radio, Inc., is permanently suspended.
2. Case No. 9125 is discontinued.
