ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Applicant, Cecil Wells, sought a certificate of public convenience and necessity as a passenger stage corporation between Livermore, Pleasanton and Dublin, on the one hand, and San Francisco, on the other hand.

A protest was filed by Greyhound Lines - West. Public hearing was held before Examiner O'Leary at San Francisco on June 28, 1971. Notice of the hearing was mailed to applicant and interested parties on June 1, 1971. The applicant did not appear at the hearing.
