OPINION AND ORDER

Exception Ratings Tariffl(ERT 1) contains less-truckload exception ratings for the transportation of furniture and related articles, which apply in lieu of those named in National Motor Freight Classification A-ll (Governing Classification). These ratings refer to items in the Governing Classification for descriptions of the commodities involved. By this petition, Furniture Manufacturers Association of California seeks to have ERT 1 amended effective September 1, 1971, setting forth therein such commodity descriptions. Relief from the long- and short-haul provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code is also requested.

Petitioner states that the Commission established the exception ratings on furniture and related articles for the purpose of effecting an orderly transition to the Governing Classification. Petitioner avers that these exception ratings were maintained pending the outcome of an investigation by the Interstate Commerce Commission (I.C.C. Docket No. 34922 - Classification Ratings on Furniture) into the reasonableness of the increased furniture ratings in the Governing Classification and that the above Commission subsequently ordered that the involved classification ratings be canceled and the former ratings be reinstated. Petitioner alleges that the National Classification Board issued a Special Docket containing revised descriptions and ratings on

furniture and that the exception ratings in question continued to be maintained in lieu of the revised ratings in the Governing Classification awaiting disposition of said docket.

Petitioner declares that adoption of National Motor Freight Classification A-12 as the Governing Classification to replace National Motor Freight Classification A-11, as proposed in another proceeding before the Commission, would affect the current exception ratings on furniture and related articles inasmuch as the descriptions for these commodities differ in the two classifications. Petitioner asserts that, in view of the present proceedings before the National Classification Board concerning revised ratings and descriptions on furniture, it would appear prudent temporarily to retain the current descriptions on furniture and related articles by establishing such descriptions in ERT 1.

Copies of the petition were mailed to California Trucking Association on July 2, 1971. The petition was listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar of July 7, 1971. No objection to the granting of the petition has been received.

Commission staff analysis indicates that certain classification descriptions for which exception ratings are currently provided in ERT 1 will not be set forth in National Motor Freight Classification A-12. In order to retain the present classification ratings on furniture and related articles until the proceedings before the National Classification Board concerning these commodities are resolved, the status quo in this matter can best be preserved by publishing the governing commodity descriptions in ERT 1. Petitioner's proposal would result in neither increases nor reductions. The staff recommends that petitioner's proposal, with minor technical changes in certain descriptions, be granted by ex parte order.

C. 7858 (Pet. 102) - 1tc In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that petitioner's proposal is reasonable and that the resulting rates and charges will be just, reasonable and nondiscriminatory minimum rates and charges for the transportation involved. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the petition should be granted. IT IS ORDERED that: 1. Exception Ratings Tariff 1 (Appendix A to Decision No. 66195, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective September 1, 1971, the original and revised pages attached hereto and listed in Appendix A also attached hereto, which pages and appendix by this reference are made a part hereof. 2. Common carriers subject to the Public Utilities Act, to the extent that they are subject to Decision No. 66195, as amended, are hereby directed to establish in their tariffs the amendments necessary to conform with the further adjustments ordered herein. 3. Tariff publications required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein shall be filed not carlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than one day after the effective date of this order on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and to the public; and tariff publications which are authorized but not required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not earlier than the first day after the effective date of this order and may be made effective on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the minimum rate tariff pages incorporated in this order. 4. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the ratings authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart -3from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the ratings published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

5. In all other respects Decision No. 66195, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be August 27, 1971.


