ORDER OF DISMISSAL

In this case the Commission issued an Order Instituting Investigation for the purpose of determining, among other things, whether Brink's Incorporated, hereinafter referred to as Brink's, has operated or is operating as an express corporation as defined in Section 219 of the Public Utilities Code without obtaining the authority as required by Section 1010 of said code.

On the basis of the facts disclosed by our staff we find that there is insufficient evidence on which to make a finding of public utility status and thus no reason to continue the course of this proceeding.

Therefore, the proceeding in this matter will be discontinued and the Order Instituting Investigation in Case No. 9229 is dismissed.
