SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 78335 dated February 22, 1971, in the above proceeding, the Commission granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing operations as a cement carrier to Peters Trucking Service, Inc. It has been brought to our attention that Appendix A of said decision did not contain a restriction necessitated by an existing carrier-shipper relationship.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that the necessary restriction should be made by the order herein. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that Decision No. 78335, supra, should be amended accordingly.

Peters Trucking Service, Inc., a corporation, by the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by the decision noted in the margin, is authorized to conduct operations as a cement carrier as defined in Section 214.1 of the Public Utilities Code from any and all points of origin to any and all points within the counties of Colusa, Nevada, Placer, Sacramento, San Francisco, San Matco, Santa Clara and Sutter, subject to the following restrictions:

- 1. Whenever Peters Trucking Service, Inc., a corporation, engages other carriers for the transportation of property of Concrete Service Co. or customers or suppliers of said company, Peters Trucking Service, Inc. shall not pay such other carriers rates and charges less than the rates and charges published in Peters Trucking Service, Inc.'s tariffs on file with the Commission for the transportation actually performed by such other carriers.
- 2. This certificate of public convenience and necessity shall lapse and terminate if not exercised for a period of one year.
