OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 78797, dated June 15, 1971, in these proceedings, adopted the provisions of Supplement 28 to National Motor Freight Classification A-11 to govern the Commission's minimum class-rate tariffs and approved such provisions for application by common carriers, with the exception of the changes contained in the Sheet Steel Container Group (Items 52755-A through 52838-B as listed in Supplement 28). Ordering paragraph 5 of Decision No. 78797 ordered that a public hearing be scheduled for the receipt of evidence concerning the application to intrastate traffic of Items 52755-A through 52838-B as listed in Supplement 28 to the Classification.





C. 5432, Pet. 653 et al. JR

A public hearing in these matters was held on July 28, 1971, at which time petitioner and applicant stated that they no longer desire to pursue the authority sought in the application and petitions herein with respect to Items 52755-A through 52838-B in Supplement 28 to the Classification, and requested that ordering paragraph 5 of Decision No. 78797 be vacated.

IT IS ORDERED that ordering paragraph 5 of Decision No. 78797 is vacated and, except to the extent granted by Decision No. 78797, the application and petitions herein are dismissed.
