ORDER EXTENDING TEMPORARY MODIFICATION OF OPERATING AUTHORITY GRANTED IN DECISION NO. 77768

By Decision No. 77768 dated September 22, 1970, in Application No. 52165, the Commission granted Air California (Air Cal) temporary authority to modify its nonstop operating authority between San Diego and San Jose to permit it to operate this service via Orange County Airport (Sante Ana).

The time period for this temporary modification was extended to August 31, 1971 by Decision No. 78276, dated February 2, 1971. This decision consolidated Air Cal's application with Phase I of Application No. 51080 filed by Pacific Southwest Airlines. Public hearing in these consolidated matters is scheduled to commence September 7, 1971 in San Diego.

By the petition filed herein, Air Cal requests that the termination date of August 31, 1971, set forth in Decision No. 78276, be extended to February 29, 1972 to allow for completion of the decision-making process. Air Cal also requests that the temporary authority to carry local passengers between San Diego and Crange County Airport, which was granted by Decision No. 78299, dated February 9, 1971, be extended to the same date.

The Commission concludes that the requests are reasonable and should be granted. No protest has been filed to the requests for the extensions.

IT IS ORDERED that the temporary authority granted by Decisions Nos. 77768 and 78299, dated September 22, 1970 and February 9, 1971, respectively, is extended to remain in effect until February 29, 1972.
