ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision No. 69056, dated May 12, 1965, in Application No. 47502, The Western Pacific Railroad Company (Western Pacific) was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to transport passengers and their baggage between The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company (Santa Fe) bus terminal at 44 Fourth Street, San Francisco, and The Western Pacific railroad yard, Middle Harbor Road, Oakland. Said authority was granted to accommodate the transportation of passengers moving on prior or subsequent rail transportation via Western Pacific's California Zephyr, formerly its Trains Nos. 17 and 18.

The application alleges that as a result of the Rail Passenger Service Act of 1970 (Public Law 91-518) and the execution of a valid contract by and between Western Pacific and the National Railroad Passenger Corporation (AMTRAK) for the operation commencing May 1, 1971 of intercity passenger trains serving Oakland heretofore operated by it, Western Pacific has ceased its operation of all rail passenger service which connected with the passenger stage service authorized in Decision No. 69056.

The application herein seeks authority to discontinue passenger stage service by Western Pacific between its San Francisco and Oakland passenger terminals and the revocation of the certificate granted by Decision No. 69056.

It appears and the Commission finds that the foregoing circumstances constitute good cause for the revocation of the aforementioned certificate. The Commission concludes that the certificate should be revoked and the tariffs and timetables applicable to the service thereunder should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation between the points authorized by Decision No. 69056 in Application No. 47502 is hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in connection with service under said certificate are canceled upon the effective date of this order.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
