## Decision No. 79104

BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

Application of the State of California, Department of Public Works, for an order authorizing the alteration of the existing Costa Bella Drive (a county road, formerly North Avenue) Grade Crossing PUC No. 36D-10.3 over the Lakeside Branch tracks of San Diego and Arizona Eastern Railway Company in Lemon Grove, County of San Diego.

Application No. 52604 (Filed May 7, 1971)

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State of California Department of Public Works in connection with the improvement of a portion of State Route 94 which includes the construction of a new interchange at Costa Bella Drive is hereby authorized to widen existing Costa Bella Drive, formerly North Avenue (Crossing No. 36D-10.3) across the La Mesa Branch tracks of the San Diego and Arizona Eastern Railway Company in Lemon Grove, San Diego County, as described and substantially as shown on Exhibits "A" and "C", attached to the application. Construction of the crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection at the crossing shall be by four Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B) augmented with automatic gate arms. Backlights may be omitted from the signals to be mounted on the center medians. Such protection shall be placed in service before the alteration work is completed and the crossing is fully opened to vehicular traffic. No obstructions shall be placed or remain near the flashing light signals which will impair the motorists' view.

Construction and maintenance expenses of the crossing shall be borne in accordance with an agreement entered into between the parties.

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Clearances shall conform to General Order No. 26-D. Within the area of the grade crossing construction, walkways for a distance of 6' from the rail on both sides of the track shall provide a reasonable regular surface with gradual slope not to exceed 1" vertical to 8" horizontal in all directions of approach in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 118.

Installation cost of the automatic crossing protection shall be divided equally between the applicant and the railway.

Maintenance cost of the automatic protection shall be divided equally between the County of San Diego and the railway in accordance with agreement entered into between the parties and pursuant to the provisions of Section 1202.2 of the Public Utilities Code.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
