## SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 78541 dated April 13, 1971, in the above proceeding, the Commission granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing operations as a highway common carrier to James Livesay. It has been brought to our attention that said decision did not indicate that the certificate granted to Portola Drayage Co. was previously amended by Decision No. 74082, dated May 7, 1968, in Application No. 48547.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that the necessary correction should be made by the order herein. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that Decision No. 78541, supra, should be amended accordingly.

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 78541 is hereby amended by inscrting after the wording "application No. 42114," in the second paragraph of the Opinion: "as amended by Decision No. 74082, dated May 7, 1968, in Application No. 48547."
