## SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 78328, dated February 17, 1971 and effective March 9, 1971 in this proceeding, applicant was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a common carrier by vessel to transport passengers in the vessel G. T. Avalon between Los Angeles Harbor and Santa Catalina Island. The authority was subject to the condition, among others, that applicant establish the service within one hundred twenty days from the effective date of the decision. Subsequently, applicant advised that due to damage to the propulsion system of the G. T. Avalon, service could not be established within the limits of time established by Decision No. 78328. A sought extension of time of 60 days was granted by Decision No. 78896 dated July 13, 1971.

By letter dated August 17, 1971, applicant reports that the repairs to the vessel have not been completed. It expects to complete the repair work within 60 days. A further 60-day extension of time is requested within which to inaugurate the service. The request appears reasonable. The further extension will be granted.
