O R D E R

Central California Traction Company is hereby authorized to construct an additional track at grade across Florin-Perkins Road in the City of Sacramento, Sacramento County, at the location described in the application to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 61-43.6.

Width of crossing shall be not less than 40 feet and grades of approach not greater than one percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two existing Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B) supplemented with automatic gate arms.

Applicant shall bear entire expense of construction and maintenance cost of the crossing inside of lines two feet outside of rails.

Clearances shall conform to General Order No. 26-D. Within the area of the grade crossing construction, walkways for a distance of six feet from the rail on both sides of the track

shall provide a reasonable regular surface with gradual slope not to exceed one inch vertical to eight inches horizontal in all directions of approach in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 118.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
