ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Decision No. 78808 in Case No. 9197 ordered Larry L. Quigley, a sole proprietorship, to pay a fine of \$4,382.83 on or before August 29, 1971. Said respondent has paid \$1,382.83 on the fine leaving a balance of \$3,000. By letter dated September 7, 1971, Quigley has informed the Commission that his revenue has declined and requests that he be authorized to pay the balance of the fine in three equal monthly installments.

Therefore IT IS ORDERED that Larry L. Quigley, a sole proprietorship, may pay the balance of \$3,000 remaining to be paid on the fine imposed by Decision No. 78808 in three equal monthly installments of \$1,000 each due on or before the tenth day of October, November and December 1971.
