ORDER EXTENDING TIME

The County of Ventura has requested that the authority granted by Decision No. 75330 for the improvement of the Pleasant Valley Road grade crossing, No. E-411.8, on Southern Pacific Transportation Company's Coast Route be extended. Due to the necessity of Contractor-Railroad insurance agreements, the contractor was unable to commence construction until August 24, 1971.

IT IS ORDERED that the time within which to widen and improve Crossing No. E-411.8 as set forth in Decision No. 75330 is hereby extended to March 10, 1972.

In all other respects, Decision No. 75330 shall remain in full force and effect.
