ORDER GRANTING REHEARING

It further appearing that the complaint in Case No. 9177  
involves questions of law and fact related to the complaint filed

by Phonetele, Inc. vs. The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, Case No. 9265; and

It further appearing that the cease and desist order issued to General in Decision No. 78363 should continue in effect until further order of the Commission; now therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Rehearing of Decision No. 78894 is hereby granted.
2. Case No. 9177 and Case No. 9265 are hereby consolidated for hearing.
3. The cease and desist order issued in Decision No. 78363 to General Telephone Company of California shall continue in effect pending further order of this Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that public hearing in Case No. 9177 and Case No. 9265 shall be heard before Commissioner Symons or Examiner Catey at such time and place as may hereafter be designated.

The Secretary is directed to cause a copy of this order to be served upon each party in Case No. 9177 and Case No. 9265 and to cause appropriate notice of hearing to be mailed at least ten (10) days before said hearing.
