## SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Respondent, Edgar L. Kelley, Sr., having requested that he be authorized to obtain a radial highway common carrier permit in lieu of seasonal contract carrier permits authorized by Decision No. 77608; said applicant having alleged that the sought permit would allow him to work all year and thereby improve his financial ability to make amonthly payments on the balance of \$1,617.21 remaining to be paid on the fine imposed on him by Decision No. 74955; and it appearing that said Decision No. 77608 should be amended as follows:

IT IS ORDERED that Edgar L. Kelley, Sr., is authorized to have issued to him a radial highway common carrier permit upon the filing of an appropriate application therefor. Such permit, if issued, shall be made subject to the conditions that said respondent make monthly payments of \$50 or more each month, commencing one month after the effective date of the permit until the balance of the fine imposed on
