## ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE AND TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

Upon reading of the verified complaint and verified amendment to complaint on file in Case No. 9265 and the supporting verification, and it appearing to the Commission therefrom that this is a proper case for granting an order to show cause and temporary restraining order, and that unless an order to show cause and temporary restraining order is granted, complainant will suffer great and irreparable injury before the matter can be heard; therefore;

IT IS ORDERED that defendant The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company shall appear before Commissioner Symons or Examiner Catey in the Commission Courtroom, State Office Building, 350 McAllister Street, San Francisco, California, at 10:00 A.M. on October 26, 1971, and then and there show cause why a cease and desist order should not be issued prohibiting defendant The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company from interfering with the installation and performance of complainant's toll device and equipment pending further Commission order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, pending the hearing on the order to show cause, the defendant The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company is hereby restrained and ordered to cease and desist from interfering with the operation and performance of complainant's existing installations of toll device and equipment.

The Secretary is directed to cause a certified copy of this restraining order and order to show cause to be served on the parties to this complaint forthwith.
