SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

It appearing that Decision No. 79239 dated October 13, 1971, through inadvertence, omitted at mimeograph page 2 thereof the following finding:

The money or property to be procured or paid for by the issue of the stock and indebtedness herein authorized is reasonably required for the purposes specified herein, and such purposes are not, in whole or in part, reasonably chargeable to operating expenses or to income, and

It further appearing that through inadvertence the ordering portion of Decision No. 79239 omitted authorization to issue a note and a requirement for the payment of the fee therefor, and the Commission having concluded that such omissions should be remedied,

Now therefore, IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 79239 is amended in the following respects:

- a. At mimeograph page 2 there is inserted immediately following finding number 3:
  - 4. The money or property to be procured or paid for by the issue of the stock and indebtedness herein authorized is reasonably required for the purposes specified herein, and such purposes are not, in whole or in part, reasonably chargeable to operating expenses or to income.

b. There is added to the ordering portion:

- (1) Harry C. Wuner and Ruth K. Wuner are authorized to issue a promissory note in the sum of \$6,500 in the terms set forth in the foregoing opinion.
- (2) The authority herein granted to issue a note will become effective when applicant has paid the fee prescribed by Section 1904(b) of the Public Utilities Code, which fee is \$50. In other respects the effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
