ORDER REVOKING OPERATING RIGHT

Interjet Cargo System, Inc. (Interjet) was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a freight forwarder between various points in California pursuant to Decision No. 77795 as amended by Decisions Nos. 77848 and 78263 in the above proceeding.

These decisions required that Interjet establish the service authorized therein and file tariffs by August 2, 1971. The required tariff filings have not been made.¹ The certificate involved should be revoked.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that the revocation of the certificate of public convenience and necessity would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the certificate should be revoked.

Applicant's attorney has informed the Commission that Interjet is not in a position to provide the authorized service.


IT IS ORDERED that:






The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
