ORDER GRANTING PETITION FOR MODIFICATION

By Decision No. 79031, dated August 10, 1971 the Commission ordered that the defendant, Pacific Gas and Electric Company, restore electric service to the complainant's property near Scotia.

In paragraph 2.b.(1) and (2) of the Commission's order defendant was directed to provide the Commission a written cost estimate regarding restoration of service over the "Fitzpatrick route", and also a written report regarding efforts made to have the route for reconnection which is acceptable to the Division of Highways adjusted in order to permit reconnection to the complainant's land.

By the petition for modification filed on October 6, 1971 defendant states that the Division of Highways has approved a direct reconnection route which crosses U.S. Highway 101 and then runs to the complainant's land. In light of this development, defendant's petition relates, it is not necessary to consider or file reports regarding the "Fitzpatrick route" or adjustment of the only route previously acceptable to the Division of Highways. The petition further relates that defendant has obtained an encroachment

permit from the Division of Highways for the crossing of the highway, and that any further reports or studies would be a waste of time and money since all parties are now in agreement as to the route for reconnection. The complainant agrees with the defendant in this regard.

Defendant's request is reasonable and should be granted. IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Paragraphs 2.b.(1) and (2) of the Commission's order in Decision No. 79031, dated August 10, 1971, in the above-entitled matter are deleted from said order.
- 2. In all other respects Decision No. 79031 shall remain in full force and effect.
