INTERIM TARIFF SUPPLEMENT AND  
 ORDER EXTENDING EXPIRATION DATE

The above petitions for modification in Case No. 7858 filed by or on behalf of various shippers or groups or organizations of shippers request extensions, changes and/or revisions of the exception ratings in Section No. 2-B of Exception Ratings Tariff 1. Said exception ratings are scheduled to expire with December 31, 1971. All petitioners seek an ex parte order granting their request prior to the aforementioned expiration date. Because of conflicts in certain requests and the increases and reductions involved, all of the petitions will be consolidated and set for hearing. Since final disposition thereof cannot reasonably be expected prior to December 31, 1971, said expiration date will be extended until further order of the Commission.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Exception Ratings Tariff 1 (Appendix A to Decision No. 66195, as amended) is further amended to provide that the expiration date of December 31, 1971 of Items 1030, 1040 and 1050 in Section 2-B of Exception Ratings Tariff 1 is extended until further order of the Commission.

2. Tariff publications of common carriers shall be made effective not later than January 1, 1972, on five days' notice to the Commission and the public.

3. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the provisions authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the provisions published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

4. In all other respects said Decision No. 66195, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
