## ORDER VACATING ORDER PARTIALLY SUSPENDING DECISIONS

In view of the Executive Order of the President of the United States, announced August 15, 1971, imposing a freeze on price and wage increases for ninety days, rate increases authorized by the decisions listed in Appendix A attached hereto, and made a part hereof, in the above-entitled proceedings which could or would have become effective within such ninety-day period were suspended until further order of the Commission by Decision No. 79312.

The rates authorized by the decisions listed in said Appendix A are within the lower zone of reasonableness and are consistent with the purposes of the Federal Government's economic stabilization program in that the increased rates will offset only cost increases previously incurred. In the circumstances, Decision No. 79312 will be vacated and set aside.

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 79312 is hereby vacated and set aside.
