ORDER VACATING ORDER PARTIALLY SUSPENDING DECISIONS

In view of the Executive Order of the President of the United States, announced August 15, 1971, imposing a freeze on price and wage increases for ninety days, rate increases authorized by the decisions listed in Appendix A attached hereto, and made a part hereof, in the above-entitled proceedings which could or would have become effective within such ninety-day period were suspended until further order of the Commission by Decision No. 79313.

The rates authorized by the decisions listed in said Appendix A are within the lower zone of reasonableness and are consistent with the purposes of the Federal Government's economic stabilization program in that the increased rates will offset only cost increases previously incurred. In the circumstances, Decision No. 79313 will be vacated and set aside.

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Decision No. 79313 is hereby vacated and set aside.
- 2. Minimum Rate Tariff 1-B (Appendix B of Decision No. 65834, as amended) is hereby further amended by incorporating therein Supplement 5, which supplement is attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
- 3. Minimum Rate Tariff 2 (Appendix D to Decision No. 31606, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein Supplement 79, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
- 4. Minimum Rate Tariff 9-B (Appendix A to Decision No. 67766, as amended) is hereby further amended by incorporating therein Supplement 8, which supplement is attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

- 5. Minimum Rate Tariff 12 (Appendix A of Decision No. 50218, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein Supplement 3, which supplement is attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
- 6. Minimum Rate Tariff 19 (Appendix A of Decision No. 41363, as amended) is hereby further amended by incorporating therein Supplement 16, which supplement is attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
