TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER,
ORDER CONSOLIDATING PROCEEDINGS
AND
ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

Upon reading of the verified complaint and attachments thereto filed by complainant in the above-entitled proceeding, and it appearing to the Commission that there is good cause to believe that defendant may be operating, or holding itself out to operate, or soliciting business as a public utility warehouse in South San Francisco without a certificate of public convenience and necessity from this Commission, and that such activity presents a proper case for issuing a temporary restraining order and an order to show cause why defendant should not be ordered to cease and desist such activities without a certificate of public convenience and necessity from this Commission;





THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED that defendant is restrained from holding itself out as a public utility warehouse in South San Francisco, and from engaging in the activities of a public utility warehouse in South San Francisco, and soliciting business as a public utility warehouse in South San Francisco. This order shall remain in effect until further order of the Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that defendant shall appear before Examiner Cline in the Commission Courtroom, State Building, 350 McAllister Street, San Francisco, California, at 10 A.M. on December 7, 1971, and then and there show cause why a cease and desist order should not be issued prohibiting defendant USCO Services, Inc. from holding itself out, soliciting business as, and engaging in the activity of a public utility warehouse in South San Francisco until such time as it has obtained a certificate of public convenience and necessity from this Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Case No. 9293 is consolidated with Application No. 52791, USCO Services, Inc.

The Secretary is directed to cause a certified copy of this temporary restraining order, order to show cause, and order consolidating proceedings to be served on the parties to this complaint forthwith. This order shall become effective when served on defendant.
