BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Application of the County of Riverside, a political subdivision of the State of California, having corporate powers, for an order to construct a crossing at grade of the Atchison, Topeka & Santa Fe "T" Line, over Highway 71 in the Temescal area, said crossing to be known as crossing No. 2T-12.9.

O R D E R

County of Riverside is hereby authorized to construct a county road at grade across the Elsinore Branch of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company in Riverside County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. 2T-12.9.

Width of crossing shall be not less than 26 feet and grades of approach not greater than shown on plans.

Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 (General Order No. 72). Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material.

Construction expense of the crossing shall be borne by applicant.

Maintenance cost of the crossing outside of lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by applicant. The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost of the crossing between such lines.

The crossing shall not be opened to public use until after the protection ordered herein is installed.

No obstructions shall be placed or remain near the crossing signs which will impair the motorists' view.

Clearances shall conform to General Order No. 26-D. Within the area of the grade crossing construction, walkways for a distance of 6' from the rail on both sides of the track shall provide a reasonable regular surface with gradual slope not to exceed 1" vertical to 8" horizontal in all directions of approach in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 118.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
