ORDER RENEWING TEMPORARY SUSPENSION

By Decision No. 79246 Mercer Enterprises' certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing operations as a passenger air carrier as defined in Section 2741 of the Public Utilities Code between Burbank, Long Beach and Brown Field (San Diego County) was suspended for a period of ninety days. Said suspension will expire on December 9, 1971. By letter dated November 12, 1971 Mercer Enterprises requested said suspension be extended for an additional ninety days.

IT IS ORDERED that the suspension ordered in Decision No. 79246 is renewed for an additional ninety day period.
