C. 5432 (Pet. 582), et al. - hk INTERIM ORDER EXTENDING EXPIRATION DATES In view of the Federal Government's economic stabilization program which provides for controls on price and wage increases, the expiration of certain tariff provisions, which would otherwise result in rate increases, will be extended until further order of the Commission. IT IS ORDERED that: 1. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 10 (Appendix A to Decision No. 44633, as amended) is further emended by incorporating therein Supplement 17 attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof. 2. Exception Ratings Tariff No. 1 (Appendix A to Decision No. 66195, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein to become effective January 1, 1972, Supplement 10, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof. 3. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 1-B (Appendix B to Decision No. 65834, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein to become effective January 1, 1972, Supplement 6, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof. 4. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 (Appendix D to Decision No. 31606, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein to become effective January 1, 1972, Supplement 81, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof. 5. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 9-B (Appendix A to Decision No. 67766, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein to become effective January 1, 1972, Supplement 9, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof. -2-

- 6. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 19 (Appendix A to Decision No. 41363, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein to become effective January 1, 1972, Supplement 17, attached
- 7. Common carriers subject to the Public Utilities Act, to the extent that they are subject to Decision No. 44633, as amended, and maintained in their tariffs on August 15, 1971, the provisions set forth in Supplement 16 to Minimum Rate Tariff No. 10, are hereby directed to establish in said tariffs the amendments necessary to conform with the further adjustments ordered herein.
- 8. Common carriers subject to the Public Utilities Act, to the extent that they are subject to Decisions Nos. 31606, 41363, 65834, 66195 and 67766, as amended, and currently maintain in their tariffs the provisions being amended by Ordering Paragraphs 2 through 6 hereof, are hereby directed to establish in said tariffs the amendments necessary to conform with the further adjustments ordered in said ordering paragraphs.
- 9. Tariff publications required to be made by common carriers as a result of Ordering Paragraph 1 hereof shall be filed to become effective not later than December 18, 1971, on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public; and tariff publications which are authorized but not required to be made by common carriers as a result of Ordering Paragraph 1 hereof may be made effective on one day's notice to the Commission and the public if filed not later than February 7, 1972.

- 10. Tariff publications required to be made by common carriers as a result of Ordering Paragraphs 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 hereof shall be filed to become effective January 1, 1972, on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and to the public; and tariff publications which are authorized but not required to be made by common carriers as a result of said ordering paragraphs may be made effective on one day's notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than March 1, 1972.
- ll. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the provisions authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the provisions published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.
- 12. In all other respects Decisions Nos. 31606, 41363, 44633, 65834, 66195 and 67766, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
