ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By Decision No. 78907, dated July 13, 1971, Maudene Clark as Administratrix of the Estate of Bob W. Clark, doing business as Wilco Vacuum Service & Oilfield Vacuum Service, was authorized to sell and transfer and Diversified Chemicals Corp., doing business as Wilco Trucking Division of Di-Chem, was authorized to purchase and acquire certain operating equipment and a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing operations as a petroleum irregular route carrier. Because of a delay in settling the estate of the deceased it requested that the time for complying with the provisions of Decision No. 78907 be extended from December 1, 1971, to March 1, 1972.


Therefore, good cause appearing,
