ORDER DENYING REHEARING AND MODIFYING DECISION NO. 79226

IT IS ORDERED that rehearing of Decision No. 79226 is hereby denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that conclusion paragraph 1 on mimeograph page 5 of Decision No. 79226 shall be modified to read

C. 9209 MW

as follows:

"1. Defendant's tariff is ambiguous with respect to conduit requirements and should be revised so as to remove said ambiguities."

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the order set forth in Decision No. 79226 shall be modified to add ordering paragraph 4 to read as follows:

"4. The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, following consultation with the Commission's staff, shall, within ninety (90) days of the effective date of this order, revise its tariff so as to remove present ambiguities with respect to conduit requirements."

The Secretary is directed to cause personal service of this order upon complainant and defendant. The effective date of Decision No. 79226, as modified herein, shall be twenty (20) days after completion of service of this order on defendant.
