SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Gene W. East, an individual, doing business as Gene W. East Vacuum Truck Service, requests authority to suspend service as a petroleum irregular route carrier.

The operative right to conduct operation as a petroleum irregular route carrier was granted by Decision No. 50729 dated November 3, 1954, and authorizes transportation of petroleum or petroleum products, fluids, chemicals and road oils when used for drilling purposes or incidental to drilling or in connection with surfacing of roads, or the reconditioning or abandonment of oil wells or oil well sites, or in the repair of pipe line breaks, between points and places within a radius of fifty miles of the City of Torrance, California.

Mr. East has submitted a letter stating, "That due to illness Gene W. East Vacuum Truck Service is not operating," and requests that the operative right be suspended.

After consideration, the Commission finds that the proposed suspension of service would not be adverse to the public interest and concludes that it should be authorized. A public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Concurrent with the tariff filings required by Ordering Paragraph 2 hereof, the operating authority granted by Decision No. 50729 dated November 3, 1954, is hereby suspended.

2. Within thirty days after the effective date hereof and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, applicant shall amend his tariff presently on file with this Commission to reflect the authority herein granted.

3. During the period of suspension, Gene W. East shall continue to file annual report, quarterly reports and pay fees pursuant to Section 5003.1 of the Public Utilities Code.

4. Prior to the expiration date of the suspension period or the date service is resumed when the latter date is earlier than said expiration date, Gene W. East shall file a list of motor equipment to be operated and file and have in effect evidence of adequate liability insurance protection in compliance with Commission General Order No. 100-F.

5. Tariff schedules naming rates and rules governing the common carrier operation herein shall be brought up to date in compliance with all applicable Commission minimum rate orders. The required tariff filings shall be made effective on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public and the effective date of the tariff filing shall be concurrent with the expiration date of the suspension period or the date when service is resumed when the latter date is prior to said expiration date.

6. The authority to suspend operation granted herein shall expire on December 6, 1972, or upon earlier resumption of operation which may be effected upon compliance with Ordering Paragraphs 3, 4, and 5.


7. Gene W. East is placed on notice that commencement of operation under the certificate referred to in Ordering


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Paragraph 1 herein, prior to compliance with Ordering Paragraphs 3, 4 and 5, may be cause for further suspension or revocation of the operating authority of applicant.


The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
