

Decision No. 79550

BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of UNITED EXPRESSWAYS, INC. for an order authorizing and directing substitution of the name GREAT WESTERN UNIFREIGHT SYSTEM in place and stead of the name UNITED EXPRESSWAYS, INC. wherever the latter name shall appear in the official records of the Commission.

OPINION AND ORDER

United Expressways, Inc., a corporation, is a highway common carrier operating under a certificate of public convenience and necessity issued by this Commission. By the Certificate of Amendment of the Articles of Incorporation duly filed with the Secretary of the State of California on August 3, 1971, United Expressways, Inc. changed its corporate name to Great Western Unifreight System. A petition for change of corporate name having been filed by United Expressways, Inc., its certificate will be amended to show the new corporate name and it will be ordered to amend its tariffs pursuant to General Order No. 80-A. A public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. A certificate of public convenience and necessity issued by the Commission in Decision No. 61616, as amended, is further amended by substituting "Great Western Unifreight System" in place and instead of "United Expressways, Inc."

2. Within one hundred and twenty days after the date hereof, and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public, Great Western Unifreight System shall amend its tariffs on
