ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision No. 76671 in Application No. 51491, Gregory Paul Ziebarth, dba Ski Lift Shuttle Bus was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation between the Town of Mammoth Lakes and the Mammoth Mountain Ski Lift.

It has come to the Commission's attention that on or about December 1971, Ski Lift Shuttle Bus discontinued its scheduled daily service. The Commission finds that discontinuance of service to Mammoth Mountain Ski Lift is good cause for revocation of authority to operate the route.

The Commission concludes that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity of Gregory Paul Ziebarth, dba Ski Lift Shuttle Bus should be revoked.

IT IS ORDERED that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued as part of Decision No. 76671 to Gregory Paul Ziebarth, dba Ski Lift Shuttle Bus to operate as a passenger stage corporation between the Town of Mammoth Lakes and the Mammoth Mountain Ski Lift is revoked and all tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission are canceled upon the effective date of this order.
