ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision No. 74860, dated October 22, 1968 in Application No. 50516, Holiday Airlines was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger air carrier between Long Beach Airport, on the one hand, and the airports of Hollywood/Burbank and Tahoe Valley, on the other hand, the latter being both direct, as well as via airports at San Jose and Oakland.

By Decision No. 77228, dated May 19, 1970 in Application No. 51346, Holiday Airlines was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger air carrier between Long Beach and Truckee-Tahoe Airport, and by Decision No. 77155, dated April 28, 1970 in Application No. 51159, Holiday Airlines was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate between Long Beach and Los Angeles International Airport.

It has come to the Commission's attention that the carrier never established service at Long Beach Airport, and authority to do so has long lapsed. The Commission finds that nonuse of the Long Beach authority is good cause for revocation of authority for the Long Beach routes. The Commission concludes that Long Beach Airport should be deleted as a point on routes named in Holiday's Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity.

IT IS ORDERED that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger air carrier between Long Beach Airport and Tahoe Valley Airport authorized by Decision No. 74860 in Application No. 50516 is hereby revoked and that its authority be restated as set forth in Third Revised page 1 to Appendix A of Decision No. 77228 attached, and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of Holiday Airlines, Inc. and referring to Long Beach are canceled upon the effective date of this order.

The Secretary is directed to mail a certified copy of this order to Holiday Airlines, Inc., at 9841 Airport Boulevard, Los Angeles, California 90045, last known address as shown on the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the thirtieth day after the date hereof, unless before such effective date there

shall have been filed with the Commission written response to this order requesting a public hearing, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
