ORDER OF SUSPENSION


California Trucking Association filed on December 31, 1971, a petition seeking reconsideration or rehearing of Decision No. 79491, dated December 21, 1971, in the above proceeding, involving the reestablishment therein of the Small Shipment Service provisions as set forth in Item 149 of Minimum Rate Tariff 2.

Under the terms of Section 1733 of the Public Utilities Code, the effective date of the order is stayed until the petition is granted or denied. As information to interested parties affected, a suspension supplement to Minimum Rate Tariff 2 will be issued by the order herein.

IT IS ORDERED that Minimum Rate Tariff 2 (Appendix D to Decision No. 31606, as amended) is hereby further amended by incorporating therein Supplement 84, which supplement is attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
