INTERIM OPINION AND ORDER


On October 19, 1971, an "Order of Suspension and Investi-
gation" was entered which ordered an investigation into the reason-
ableness of San Jose Water Works' tariff Sheets Nos. 252-W and
253-W which were filed on September 22, 1971 under Advice Letter
No. 93. The "Order of Suspension and Investigation" also ordered
the suspension of said tariff filings for a period of ninety days.

Public hearing in the investigation was held December 10,
1971. The Commission is still evaluating the evidence presented
at the hearing. Under the circumstances the Commission finds that
the tariff filings should be suspended for an additional ~~one-hundred~~
^{sixty} ~~eighty~~ days.


IT IS ORDERED that the operation of each of the tariff
sheets hereinabove mentioned is hereby suspended until ~~two-hundred~~
^{one hundred} ~~seventy~~ days after the date such tariff would have become effective.
