SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Veltman Warehouse Co., a corporation (Veltman), possesses a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a public utility warehouseman for the operation of storage or warehouse floor space in the City of Los Angeles.

On October 28, 1971, Veltman submitted to this Commission amended Articles of Incorporation changing the corporate name of the company to Overland Terminal Warehouse Company. Accordingly, its certificate will be amended to show the new corporate name and the warehouseman will be ordered to amend its tariffs on file with the Commission pursuant to General Order No. 61-A. A public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to Veltman Warehouse Co., a corporation, by Decision No. 78796 dated June 15, 1971, in Application No. 52606, is amended by substituting therein "Overland Terminal Warehouse Company" in place and stead of "Veltman Warehouse Co."


2. Appendix A of Decision No. 78796 is amended by substituting for Original Page 1 thereof First Revised Page 1 of Appendix A attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.


3. Within one hundred and twenty days after the effective date hereof and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public, Overland Terminal Warehouse Company shall amend its tariffs on file with this Commission as required by Rule 6.2 of General Order No. 61-A.


The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Overland Terminal Warehouse Company or to mail a certified copy thereof to it at its last known address as shown in the Commission's records and to mail a copy of this order to Jack L. Dawson, Agent.


This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.

Overland Terminal Warehouse Company, a corporation, by the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by Decision No. 78796 and amended by the decision noted in the margin, is authorized to operate as a public utility warehouseman as defined in Sections 239(b) and 239(c) of the Public Utilities Code for the operation of storage or warehouse floor space as follows:
