FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Commission Decision No. 79207, dated October 5, 1971, by ordering paragraph No. 1 ordered that a certificate of public convenience and necessity is granted to Southern California Edison Company to construct, operate, maintain and use a 220-kv transmission line as described in the application. It appears that the reference to a 220-kv transmission line appeared, rather than 500-kv transmission line, due to a clerical error.

In Finding No. 2 of Decision No. 79207 the word "service" inadvertently appears for the word "scenic".

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The number "220" in ordering paragraph No. 1 of Decision No. 79207 be changed to "500".

2. The word "service" in Finding No. 2 of Decision No. 79207 be changed to "scenic".
