ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Pacific Gas and Electric Company having on January 5, 1972, requested in writing an extension of time of nine (9) months from the time limits stated in Ordering Paragraphs Nos. 1 and 3 of Decision No. 78536 to comply with Sections 192.621(b) and 192.743(c) of the Minimum Federal Safety Standards, and it appearing to the Commission that the extension should be granted because of stated delays in obtaining material, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time limit for compliance with Ordering Paragraphs Nos. 1 and 3 in Decision No. 78536 is extended to and including September 30, 1972.

In all other respects Decision No. 78536 shall remain in full force and effect.
