SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Decision No. 78614 dated April 27, 1971 ordered J.I.M. Corporation among other things to collect certain undercharges. Ordering paragraph 3 of said decision requires J.I.M. Corporation to file a report on the first Monday of each month of the undercharges remaining to be collected and the action taken to collect such undercharges.

The January 1972 report advises that on December 17, 1971 complaint for collection of undercharges, remaining to be collected, was filed in Los Angeles Municipal Court. The January report requests that future reports be filed on a quarterly rather than a monthly basis.

IT IS ORDERED that ordering paragraph 3 of Decision No. 78614 is amended as follows:

3. J.I.M. Corporation shall proceed promptly, diligently and in good faith to pursue all reasonable measures to collect the undercharges, and in the event undercharges ordered to be collected by paragraph 2 of this order, or any part of such undercharges, remain uncollected sixty days after the effective date of this

order, J.I.M. Corporation shall file with the Commission, on the first Monday of January, April, July and October, a report of the undercharges remaining to be collected, specifying the action taken to collect such undercharges and the result of such action, until such undercharges have been collected in full or until further order of the Commission.
