SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 79140, dated September 8, 1971, in Application No. 52761 authorized Raymond E. Skaggs to operate as a cement carrier from any and all points of origin to all points and places within the counties of Contra Costa, Sacramento, San Joaquin, Solano, Sonoma and Yolo. A restatement of this authority and the authority acquired from Rock Transport, Inc. in Decision No. 79574, dated January 11, 1972, in Application No. 52940 inadvertently omitted the County of Sonoma from the scope of operations authorized.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that the necessary change should be made by the order herein. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that Appendix B of Decision No. 79574, supra, should be amended accordingly.

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 79574 is hereby amended by substituting the attached First Revised Page 1 of Appendix B in the place and stead of the present Original Page 1 of Appendix B, and by substituting reference to "Decision No. 79140" in place and stead of "Decision No. 76037" in ordering paragraph 6.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.

Sacramento, San Joaquin, Shasta, Solano,  
Sonoma and Yolo.

RESTRICTION:

This certificate of public convenience and necessity shall lapse and terminate if not exercised for a period of one year.
