O R D E R

State of California Department of Public Works is hereby
authorized to construct or reconstruct crossings at separated grades
of the following public roadways over or under the trackage of the
Southern Pacific Transportation Company, in the cities of Los
Angeles, Alhambra, San Gabriel, Rosemead, and El Monte, County of
Los Angeles, at the locations and substantially as shown by plans
(Exhibit B) attached to the application:

Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossing approved by the Southern Pacific Transportation Company, shall be filed with the Commission within 180 days from the date hereof.

Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order.

Rail operations shall be suspended during construction and shall not be resumed until the minimum clearances specified in General Order No. 26-D have been provided; any walkways damaged during construction have been restored to their original condition; and walkways adjacent to any relocated, reconstructed, or new trackage conform to General Order No. 118.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization for the project shall expire if not exercised within three years, however, the work affecting the railroad shall be completed within 18 months, unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
