## ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By Decision No. 79350, dated November 22, 1971, Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., was authorized to cancel alternative rail rates in its Tariffs Nos. 16, 18 and 19 applicable to the transportation of petroleum products. The order in said decision requires that the authority be exercised within ninety days from the effective date thereof. The deadline for such tariff filings is March 10, 1972.

Applicant requests an extension of 150 days within which to file the tariff publications in the exercise of the authority. It asserts it has determined that some carriers are transporting traffic under certain of the rates authorized to be canceled and that they desire to maintain those rates. One special docket application regarding the maintenance of certain rates already has been filed and at least one more will be filed. Applicant desires to make the cancellation of rates in its Tariffs Nos. 16, 18 and 19 concurrently with the effective date of the new or revised publications that are the subject of the special docket applications.

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IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 79350 is amended by substituting the number 240 for the word ninety in paragraph 3 of the order therein.
